In accordance with the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*, this overview of our Pollution Incident Response Management Plan has been provided.

VIP has taken appropriate steps to prevent the occurrence of a pollution incident. However, should a pollution incident occur, our staff have been provided with the necessary equipment, instruction and training in accordance with the Spill Response flow chart in our *Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure* (PACT WHSE PRO 006-02) to preserve the safety of people and to minimise any environmental harm caused by an incident.
